8 DAYS HIMALAYAS & NATIONAL PARK



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Day 01 Kathmandu (D)

Upon arrival, and transfer to hotel by our local agent.

Day 02 Kathmandu – City Tour (B/L/D)

After breakfast, a city tour of Durbar Square, Pashupatinath and Boudhanath.

Durbar Square complex of palaces, courtyards and temples, built between the 12th and 18th centuries. There are also museums inside the palace building.

Pashupatinath temple: One of the most sacred Hindu shrines in the world.

Boudnath Stupa: lies about 6 km to the east of downtown Kathmandu and is the largest stupa in the valley. Afternoon tour will consist of Swoyambhunath Stupa and **Patan City**.

<u>Swoyambhunath Stupa:</u> The stupa is one of the holiest Buddhist sites in Nepal and its establishment is linked to the creation of the Kahtmandu Valley.

Patan City: Like its counterpart in Kathmandu, is an enchanting mélange of palace buildings, artistic courtyard and former Royal palace complex is the center of Patan's religious and social life, and houses a museum containing an array of bronze statues and religious objects.

Day 03 Chitwan National Park (B/L/D)

Early morning after breakfast drive to **Chitwan** which is about 165 Km and will take about 5 hours drive. **Royal Chitwan National Park** (932 Sq Km) is listed as a **World Heritage Site** and is the most popular safari destination in Nepal. It covers a unique ecosystem, containing hills, ox-bow lakes and flood plans. Dominated by Sal forests, the park has 50 species of grasses. There are 43 species of animals in the park.

Day 04 Chitwan National Park (B/L/D)

Full day of wildlife activities, such as elephant rides, jungle safari, nature walk and river canoeing.

Day 05 Pokhara (B/L/D)

After breakfast drive to **Pokhara** which will take about 4 and half hours drive and is about 137 Km. Pokhara is a place of remarkable natural beauty. The serenity of Phewa Lake and the magnificence view of the **Fishtail Summit** rising behind it create an ambiance of peace and magic, a world famous view of the Himalayas.

Day 06 Pokhara (B/L/D)

Half a day of sightseeing in Pokhara City and 1 hour boating in Lake Phewa.

Day 07 Kathmandu (B/L/D)

After breakfast drive back to Kathmandu about 6 hours drive and is approximately 200 Km. Afternoon tour Bhaktapur City . The 15th century palace of 55 windows and the National Art gallery is also housed inside.

Day 08 Kathmandu-Home (B)

Transfer to airport for your flight home.
